eDMR Reporting Mandatory December 12, 2016

The [NPDES Electronic Reporting Rule](#) makes it mandatory for all facilities that must report wastewater or stormwater data to start using Pennsylvania DEP's electronic Discharge Monitoring Reports (eDMR) system by December 12, 2016. If you are required to submit DMRs you need to register for the eDMR system. Instructions and registration documents can be found [here](#).

Revisions to NPDES General Permits for Industrial Stormwater

DEP finalized changes to the industrial stormwater general permit which include a recertification of the general permit every year to be submitted with the annual report, an annual fee of \$500, semiannual facility inspections, and changes to best management practices (BMPs) for industries based on specific sectors. Other Updates

Hazardous Waste Generator Improvements

EPA finalized the [Hazardous Waste Improvements Rule](#) on October 28, 2016. Two important changes include flexibility to generators during episodic events and allowing a very small quantity generator to send its waste to a large quantity generator under control of the same organization.

EPA's Air Pollution Control Cost Manual

EPA is accepting public comment on the Air Pollution Control Cost Manual until December 21, 2016. The manual contains chapters on control measures and is used by EPA for estimating the impacts of rulemakings and as a basis to estimate costs for pollution control.
